

## BRED BANK SOLOMON ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS: INDIVIDUAL CUSTOMERS

Financial institutions in the Solomon Islands are required by law to identify their customers and verify their customer's identity when establishing a business relationship. The Customer Identification Requirements are Name, Date of Birth, Residential or Business Address, Occupation or Business Activity, Citizenship, and Specimen Signature.

You may bring along documents from the accepted document types as listed below.

Category A - Official Documents Photographic official government documents that contain the following: image, full name, date of birth, place of birth, & expiry date	<ul> <li>Valid domestic or international passport</li> <li>Valid domestic or foreign driver's license</li> <li>Solomon Islands voter's card</li> <li>Foreign citizenship certificate</li> <li>Birth certificate attached with certified ID photo</li> <li>Other official records from the government of Solomon Islands</li> <li>Statutory Declaration (any official document from a public lawyer)</li> <li>Work Permit Card</li> </ul>		One document in A & one document in B or C
Category B - Other Authority Issued Documents Non-photographic government official documents that contain the following: full name, date of birth, & current residential address	<ul> <li>SINPF ID card with photo</li> <li>Foreign pensioner card</li> <li>Student card or registration document</li> <li>Employer introduction formal letter with common seal</li> <li>Residency or immigration permit/certificate</li> <li>Domestic or national Identity Card with photo</li> <li>Valid local/international bank card</li> <li>Payslip</li> <li>Utility Bills (less than 3 months old)</li> </ul>		
Category C - Other Identification  Standard official letter that contains the following: full name, current residential address, contact details, & duration no less than 3 months of issurance date	<ul> <li>Letter from a relative who is a BRED Bank</li> <li>Solomon customer for one year or more</li> <li>Reference from an acceptable referee</li> <li>(see categories of acceptable referees below)</li> </ul>		

## Linking Documents:

- Birth notice or certificate (applicable to minor accounts)
- Marriage certificate
- Work permit
- Residential permit
- Adoption certificate

## Categories of Acceptable Referees:

- Pastor, Priest, Bishop
- Legal practioner/Commissioner of Oath
- Justice of the Peace
- Notary public
- Registrar, Clerk or Sheriff of the High Court
- Judge or Magistrate
- Diplomatic or Consular Officer
